## BRINGING TAX PREP TO OUR COMMUNITY

311 tax returns prepared at no cost, saving a typical fee of \$250 each.

Refunds averaged \$1,000 per return.

Garnered for our community - nearly \$300,000!



## GIVING OUR STUDENTS TOOLS FOR SCHOOL

Bringing more than three pallets of school supplies valued over \$7,000 to St. Johns County schools.



## RESPONDING TO BACK-TO-BACK HURRICANES

Relief reaching into all corners of the county.

### Funds Distributed by United Way-SJC

Over \$135,000 in relief funds provided after Irma.

### Advocated for our County with Florida First Coast Fund

10 area nonprofits benefited from \$4 million fund.

### Fiscal Agent for St. Johns and Putnam Counties

### Long Term Recovery Organization

Collaborating on over 80 home repairs to date.

United Way-SJC direct investment - \$55,000.

### Facilitator for Multiple Non-Financial Contributions

Just ONE delivery brought 16,000 pounds of food and clothing to Hastings. Value estimated at nearly \$30,000 in generous giving.

### Transport for Seniors and those with Health Issues

100 Uber rides up to \$15 each brought value of \$1,500 to our community.
